General Health Assessment Status

Family Child Care Providers and staff are required to have a health assessment completed every two years as it relates to the duties and activities of caring for children. The following includes but is not limited to activities family child care providers and staff may be required to do in order to fulfill the responsibilities of a child care provider. Providers need to move quickly to supervise and assist young children; lift children, equipment, and supplies; sit on the floor and on child-size furniture; eat the same food that is served to children (with the exception of dietary restrictions); hear and see at a distance required for supervision; be absent from work for illness no more often than a typical adult, to provide continuity of care-giving relationships for children in care.
